Like so many of the people who are a part of the game of darts, this player must find time to compete while he shoulders the responsibility of raising a family. Let's talk to Derek Priest and find out more about his interesting story!

Derek lives in Fate, Texas, near Dallas. Derek and his wife, Chelsea, have been married for nine years and have two sons, Parker (2.5) and Jesse (6 months). Derek told me, "I love the game of darts, but my number one focus is family and finance." As you will see, he meets these challenges in a unique way.

parent at home while the kids are young, so right now that is my job.

Pacer: *I'm sure a lot of darters who are reading this really admire the decision you made. You kind of give a new meaning to the term, family man.*

Derek: It is all about the family. Like I said, our two main focuses are family and finance.

Pacer: *It really seems like you have a good handle on your situation, and believe me those boys will grow up faster than you can ever imagine. Now, I want you to drift back in time and tell us how Derek Priest became a dart player.*

Derek: Well, back in 2006, my brother Steve and I met in a place that is now called *The Bourbon Street Bar & Grill* in Wichita. They were having a blind draw and they asked me to play. I was like, well I've never played but I'll do my best. Somehow I got lucky and won the tournament and I was hooked the first night I ever played the game.

The next thing I knew, I couldn't get enough of the game. I was practicing two to five hours every day and really trying to become a good dart player. Chris Martin, who everybody calls 'Turbo', was the best player in the Wichita area and I told myself if you want to be

Pacer: *Tell us why you said that your current job is by far and away, the toughest one you've ever had.*

Derek: (Laughing) Well, I've chosen to be a stay at home dad and believe me, Parker and Jesse do a great job of keeping Dad busy.

Pacer: *I had three sons, so I can totally relate to your situation. In all honesty, I don't think I could have been able to handle the challenge like you have.*

Derek: It is a challenge, but my wife, Chelsea, is a practicing attorney, and she has devoted so many years into her education so it didn't make sense for her to stay home with the kids. We wanted a

the best you have to beat the best and I decided that I was going to do whatever it took to make myself competitive against 'Turbo'. Chris is one of those great players who a lot of people don't know about because he hasn't had the opportunity to travel a lot. It took a whole lot of practice and hard work, but today when I look at the players I am competing with and against, I am really totally amazed. I never thought I would accomplish what I have.

Pacer: *The first week of January you got your year off to a great start at the Texas Regional and that tournament was literally stacked with great players.*

Derek: There are so many great players. Of course the Pro divisions are incredible but even the open events are getting tough because the fields are so much larger and

good amateurs are popping up all over the place.

Pacer: *Well, let's list your successes at the Regional. You had a 1st in the Mixed Triples with Ken Swanson and Debra Ivey, a 1st in the Mixed Doubles Cricket with Debra, and 4th in the Pro Men's Doubles 501 and the Pro/Am Cricket with Ken. Last but not least, you had a very impressive 4th in the Pro Cricket Singles, an event that was loaded with great shooters.*

Derek: Tom, when I think about where I am competitive-wise right now, it really seems surreal to me. I'll tell you one thing I am not a pretty player to watch. Honestly, I have an ugly stroke.

Pacer: *(Both Laughing) So you don't think people will copy your style of play?*

Derek: Oh no, not at all. I really have some terrible mechanics. It's kind of like, I just choose a target and shoot at it and it seems to work, but I wouldn't recommend my style to anyone.

Pacer: *Well the old saying is, "if it ain't broken don't fix it" and I would say you have found out what works for you and my advice would be to ride that horse as long as it's running good.*

Derek: I'm really happy with my progress, but I have seen videos of myself in competition and I think to myself how in the hell am I hitting my target?

Pacer: *Tell us about the experiences you've had at the BullShooter Challenge of Champions in Chicago.*

Derek: Well Tom, like I told you right now the two most important things for me is family and finances, so I'm not traveling as much as I would like, but Chelsea is more than understanding about darts.

She knows what the game means to me, and encourages me to play. In fact a few years ago, I won a tournament in Pennsylvania and had my trophy picture taken with her and Parker when he was three months old. I've been able to go to Chicago three times and this is the way I explain the results. The first tournament, I was there to strickly donate and I did a good job.

The next time I went it was more of a break even situation and that was a little better.

Then last year at BullShooter 33, I actually came a little bit ahead, got to experience the Bullpen, and had an absolutely great time! I'm hoping John Foreman will be able to make it to Chicago this year and partner up with me. Also, I would like to mention that I am a member of *Team Extreme Darts* based in Virginia. They are all about helping players and supporting the game of darts. I'm proud to be associated with them.

Pacer: *Derek Priest is a prime example of how dart players across the country and around the world juggle everyday life, and still find time to be a part of the giant dart family. Looking forward Derek told me, "As the kids get older and get involved with school, and other things I will have more time to practice and compete and we'll see where it takes me. Hopefully someday Parker and Jesse will be some of my competition. Parker already has his little set of darts and loves to throw at the board. It would be real-*

ly great if that comes to pass." Then his focus would be family, finances, and darts.
