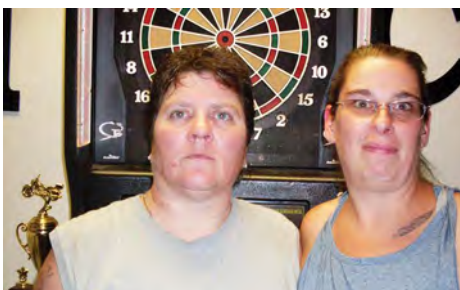
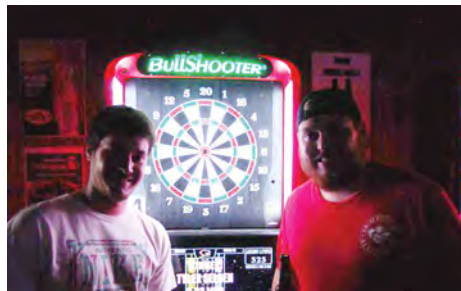

Pacer: *I have asked hundreds of dart players just how and where they got interested in the game of darts, but I have to admit your answer was a first for me.*

Heather: *(Both Laughing)* Yeah I could tell you were kind of shocked when I said Anchorage, Alaska.

Pacer: *I believe you are the first darter I ever met who started playing in Alaska, tell me about it.*

Heather: Well, in 2006, I was working at TJ's in Anchorage, which was really a super active dart bar. There were leagues almost every night and blind draws on the weekend. Darts were really, really popular.



Heather teamed up with Lee Gilreath and won 1st place in Mixed Doubles Cricket at the BullShooter Georgia Regional in March.

After interviewing dart players from different parts of the country and around the world for three decades, it is rare for a darter to surprise me with their answers! That, however, is exactly what this darter did! Let's talk darts with Heather Dupes and find out exactly what surprised me.

Heather lives in Woodstock, GA, located in the Northwestern part of the state with her husband of ten years, Michael and her stepdaughter, Debbie, who is 12.

Heather Dupes

Pacer: *So, up in Alaska, darts were the cool thing to do? (Pardon the pun)*

Heather: *(Laughing)* Tom, it really was. My husband had grown up around the game because his mom was super into it, and when we started dating, they just kind of introduced me to the game. For a couple years I just subbed on and off in the lower tiered leagues, and then I started playing on four-man team leagues. Those guys really helped me to get better.

Alvin Alzaga, who was a Grand Master player, took me under his wing and started shooting doubles with me. He really refined my game both physically and mentally and before I knew it, I was competing with the top tiered players in the area. I truly think playing with the guys and exposing myself to tougher competition helped me develop as a dart player. You know, get better or lose a lot.

Pacer: *Over the years, I've had a lot of people tell me that they worked hard and got better because they got tired of losing. I think for competitive people, losing is a motivation and for non-competitive people it is a reason to quit. Quite obviously, you must be competitive.*

Heather: Yes, I would say so. My husband and some of his friends developed Women's leagues and Singles events and that really got me stirred up competitively.

Pacer: *I can honestly say that the level of skill that the lady darters have developed over the years has been nothing short of amazing. When I watch some of you ladies playing today, I feel fortunate that my darts are long retired.*

Heather: Tom, I can only say yes, yes, yes to that. We are running a Women's circuit in the Southeast where we have tournaments in different states on a monthly basis and every year you can see the competition just getting better.

Playing in high stress matches like that gives a lot of girls the confidence to move on to bigger and better things. When you go to a big tournament, you have the confidence to compete. You give yourself a chance to play your best darts.

Pacer: *I can only say that you girls have really impressed this old darter. Heather, I have to ask just what brought about*

your big climate change?

Heather: Well, in one word, my husband's job. His company was bought out and we were given a few choices where we could relocate, so we ended up in Louisiana for a couple years and then we moved to Georgia. It looks like we will be here for the foreseeable future.

Pacer: *Man, from Alaska to the Southeastern United States, is a hell of a climate change.*

Heather: It really was a shock to our system, but once we moved to Georgia and found out how popular darts are and how many opportunities there were, it really made it nice. I mean almost weekly you can find a tournament somewhere.

Pacer: *In other words, if you want to play, the opportunity is there.*

Heather: I have been so fortunate to play in so many major steel and soft-tip tournaments. The competition has really helped me become a better player. Today people who work a lot or have to travel a lot have the luxury to play online and be able to schedule their match times. It's got to keep growing to get better. There are wonderful opportunities out there. I got to play in some amazing places like going to Taiwan and play for team USA.

Pacer: *Boy, it's a long way from Alaska to Taiwan, that had to be quite an experience.*

Heather: It really was. One of the shocking things was the level of participation there. Just the sheer number of players was amazing.

The game is just so popular, you can hardly move in a dart room over there. That made me realize how important it is for experienced darters to go out of their way to mentor young players and get as many new people involved in the game as possible. You never know when spending a few minutes

with a young player can result in another lifetime player. The game is great, but if we can get more and more people involved it will only get better. It doesn't matter if you're a fun-loving, social player or a highly competitive darter, lets all enjoy the game of darts and help it get bigger and bigger. New people are the future of the game.

Pacer: *Heather, I can only add a big amen, to that. I think you realize opportunities you have enjoyed and the fact that you want to see others have those opportunities is very commendable. One of the opportunities you have enjoyed the last couple of years is some great success at the Georgia Regional.*

Heather: It's really kind of exciting. Lee Gilreath, who I love playing with, and I won the Mixed Cricket in 2018 and came back and won the Mixed Doubles this year. Also, Elizabeth Sumner and I swept both of the Women's Doubles. It was a great couple of tournaments. Really, I look at everything I've been able to accomplish and am really amazed. It can be an expensive hobby sometimes so I want to be sure and thank Dart Junkies from Georgia, who have been very helpful. Really, I am just excited to keep playing and enjoy the future of the game. I think I will be playing for a long time.

Pacer: *Talking to Heather, it was obvious that she has a real love for the game of darts and its players. She plays in various places like Mazzies in Kennesaw, Kastaways in Marietta,*

and Giggity's in Rome. I guess after you have played from Alaska to Taiwan driving around Georgia to play darts is no big deal!

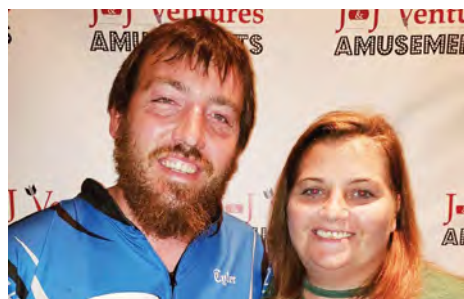
